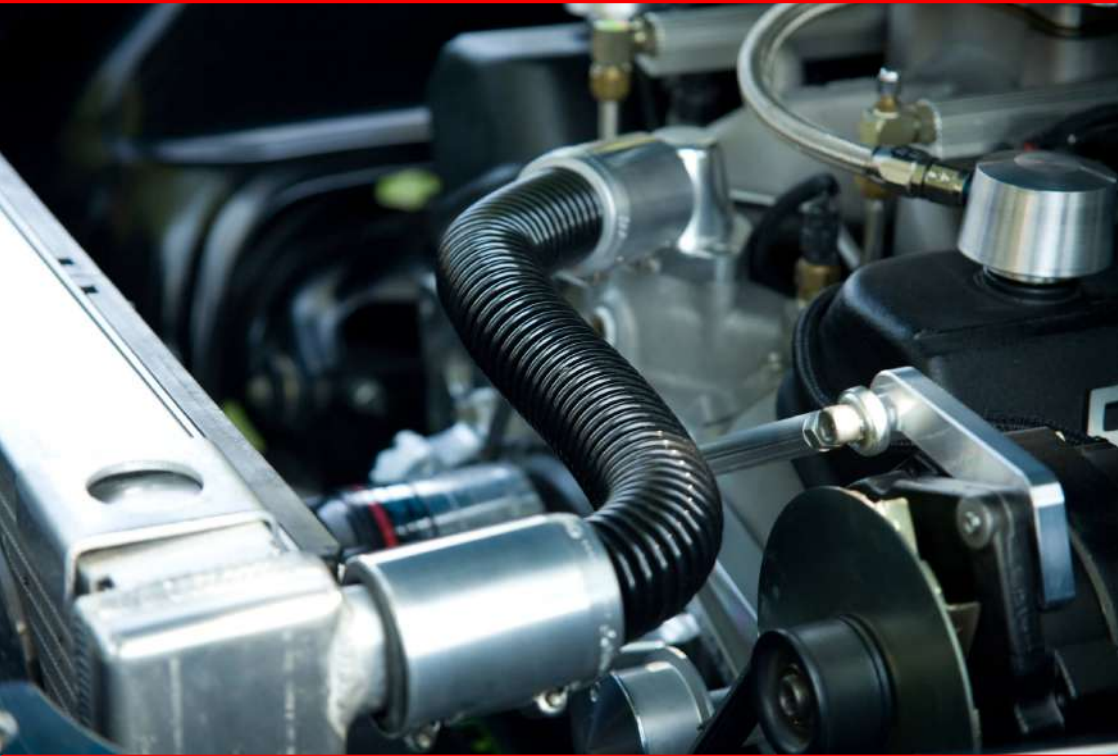

What Are The Signs Your Hoses Are In Need of Hydraulic Repair?

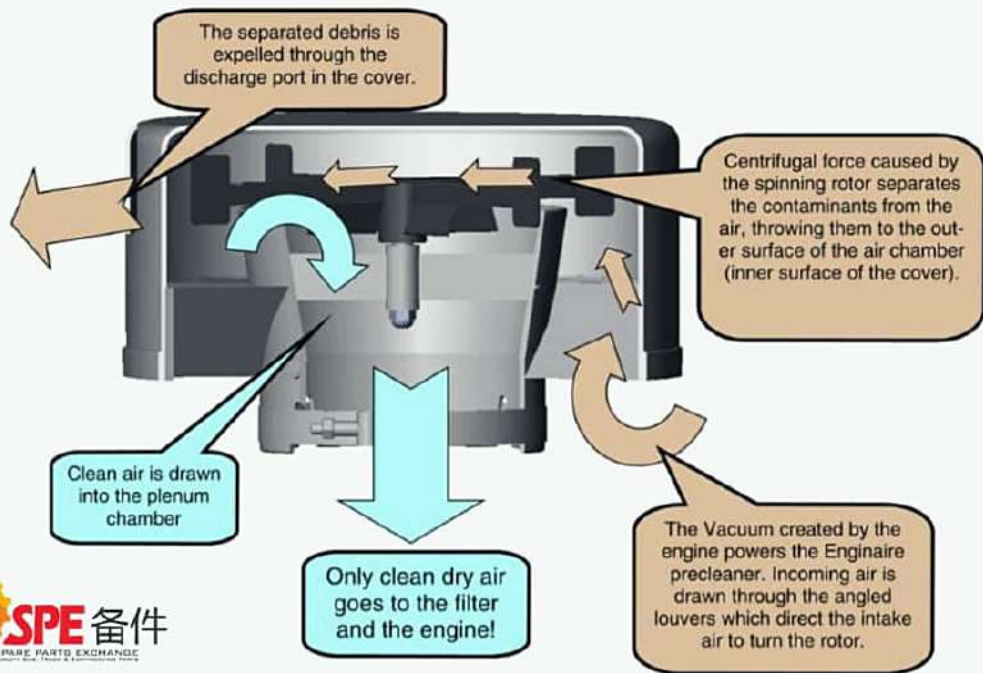
1. Exposed wire

COVID-19 Overview & Vaccines Advice

Overview

Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is an infectious disease caused by a newly discovered coronavirus. Most people infected with the COVID-19 virus will experience mild to moderate respiratory illness and recover without requiring special treatment. Older people, and those with underlying medical problems like cardiovascular disease, diabetes, chronic respiratory disease, and cancer are more likely to develop serious illness.

The best way to prevent and slow down transmission is to be well informed about the COVID-19 virus, the disease it causes and how it spreads. Protect yourself and others from infection by washing your hands or using an alcohol based rub frequently and not touching your face.

The COVID-19 virus spreads primarily through droplets of saliva or discharge from the nose when an infected person coughs or sneezes, so it's important that you also practice respiratory etiquette (*for example, by coughing into a flexed elbow*).

GET VACCINATED EVEN IF YOU HAVE HAD COVID-19

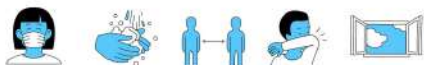

TYPICAL SIDE EFFECTS OF THE COVID-19 ARE:

- 1 Tiredness and headache
- 2 Fever
- 3 Chills
- 4 Pain or swelling at the injection site



In most cases, these are normal and last a short time.

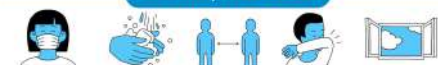
Contact your care provider if the tenderness or pain where you got the shot increases after 24 hours, or the side effects do not go away after a few days.



Over-the-counter medicines may relieve some of these symptoms, but talk to your care provider first. Patients with certain conditions like peptic ulcer or chronic renal disease may need to follow some precautions when taking these medications.

- Ibuprofen
- Aspirin
- Antihistamines

- When indoors with others, ensure good ventilation, such as by opening a window

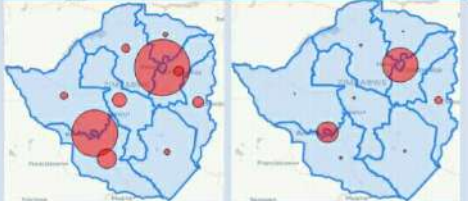

Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 13/06/2021

- HIGHLIGHTS TODAY**
- **107 New Cases**(All Local) and **No Deaths** reported today. (These cases include 28 from Masvingo whose samples were collected yesterday, and results were reported today)
 - [7 day rolling average* for new cases rises to 110 today from 97 yesterday]
 - **Lockdown Update:** The following hotspot areas have been put under localised lockdowns: Kariba, Karoi and Kwekwe
 - **Vaccination Update:** 967 received their 1st dose today bringing cumulative for 1st dose to 693 147 while 2 693 received their 2nd dose bringing cumulative for 2nd dose to 413 911. (as of 1600hrs)
 - As of 12 June 2021, @1500hrs there were 89 hospitalised cases: Asymptomatic 11, mild to moderate 54, severe 20 and 2, in intensive Care Units (Thrognog, Mtshini and Muti North & South did not report today)
 - 1 353 tests done today (Positivity today was 7.9%)
 - 12 new recoveries: National Recovery rate stands at 93% & Active cases go up to 1 323.
 - As of 13 June 2021, Zimbabwe has recorded 39 959 Cases 37 004 recoveries & 1632 Deaths.
